Through a very delicate process, the eggs are milked, fertilized and placed into beakers until hatched. The fry then live in large aerated tanks in the Hatchery till large enough to be put into one of the 3 rearing ponds. In the fall they are measured, counted, and then released into our lake where they continue to grow and improve our game fishing experience.

Other responsibilities of the Fishing Club are mending nets, cleaning tanks, feeding fry, collecting and releasing, all in addition to a monthly gathering where we combine work and fellowship.
